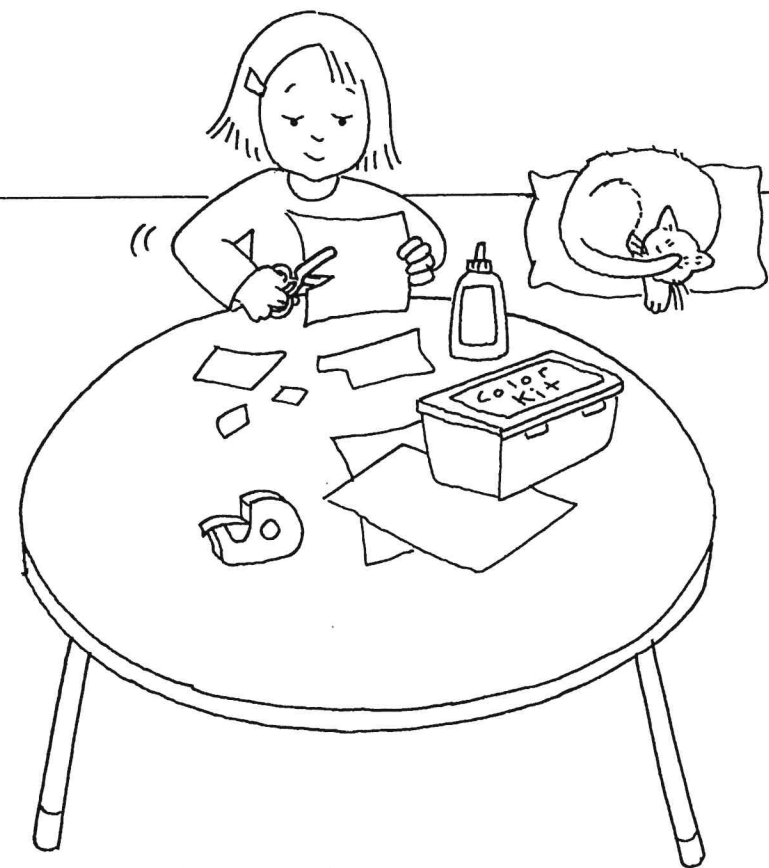

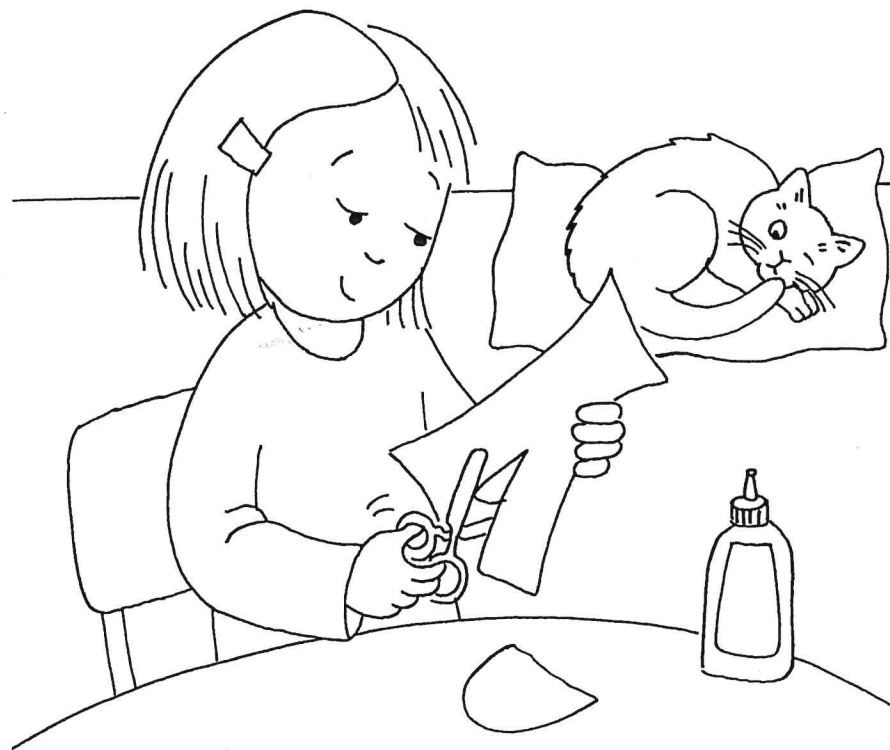

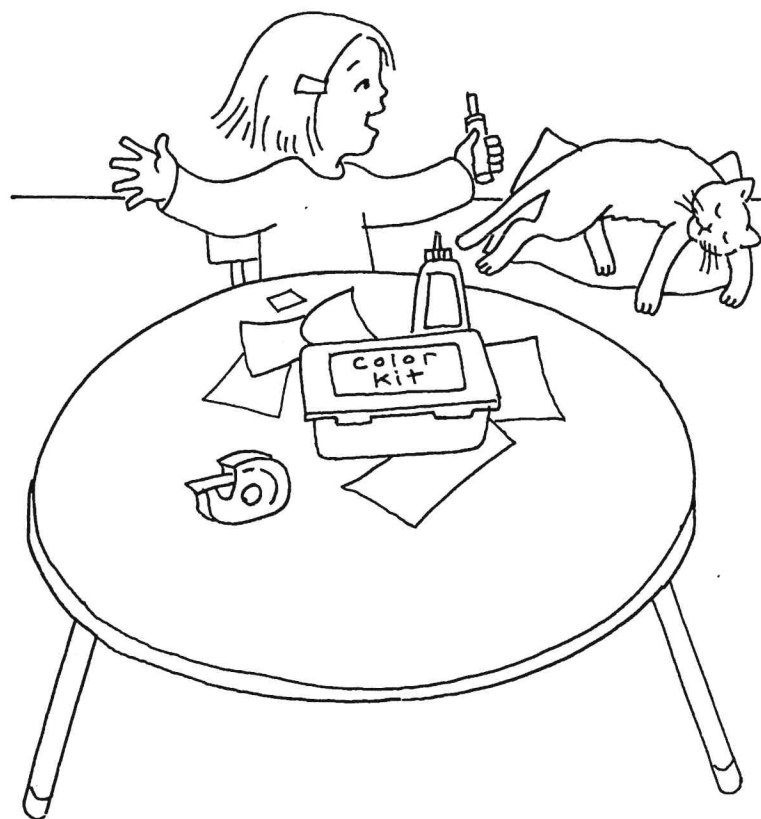
Cat sits still and naps.
I craft a cap!



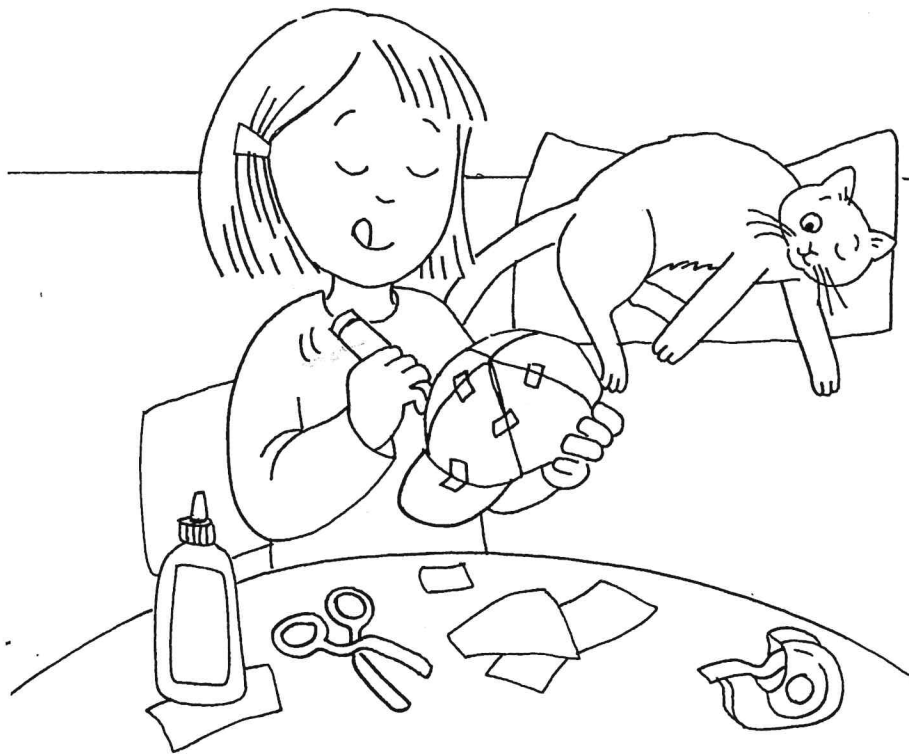
“Can you snip?” I ask Cat.

I grip a tan color.



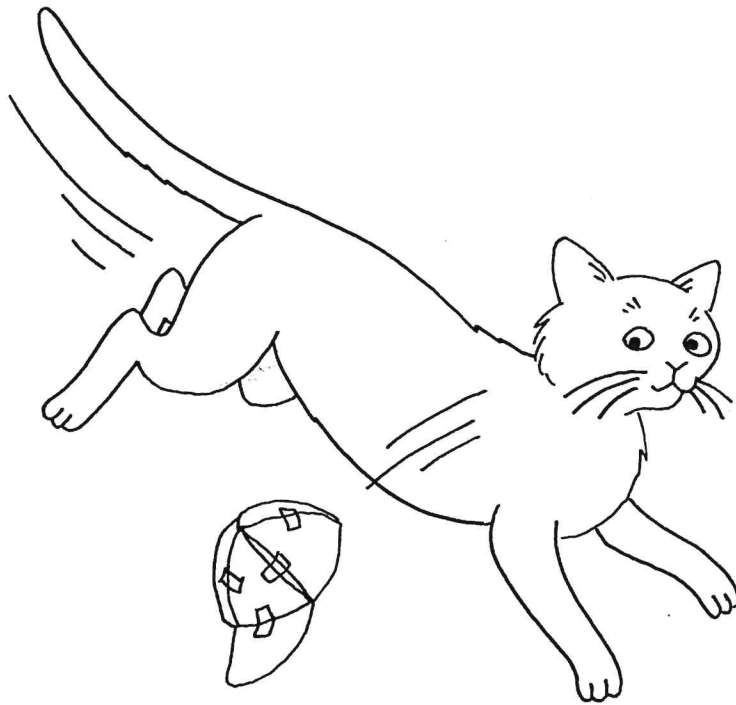
"Can you color?" I ask Cat.
