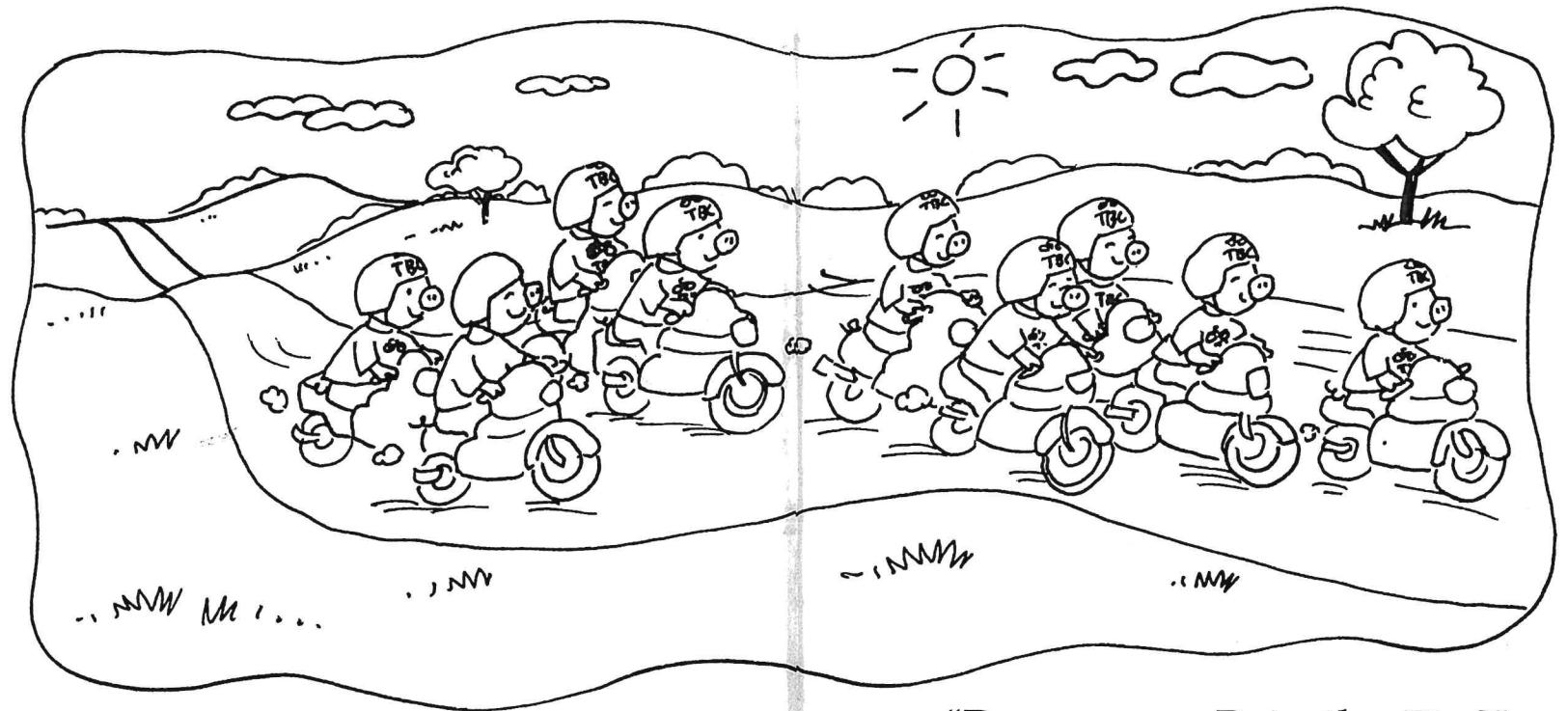


“Here is The Bike Club.  
I’ll go in,” said Pete the Pig.



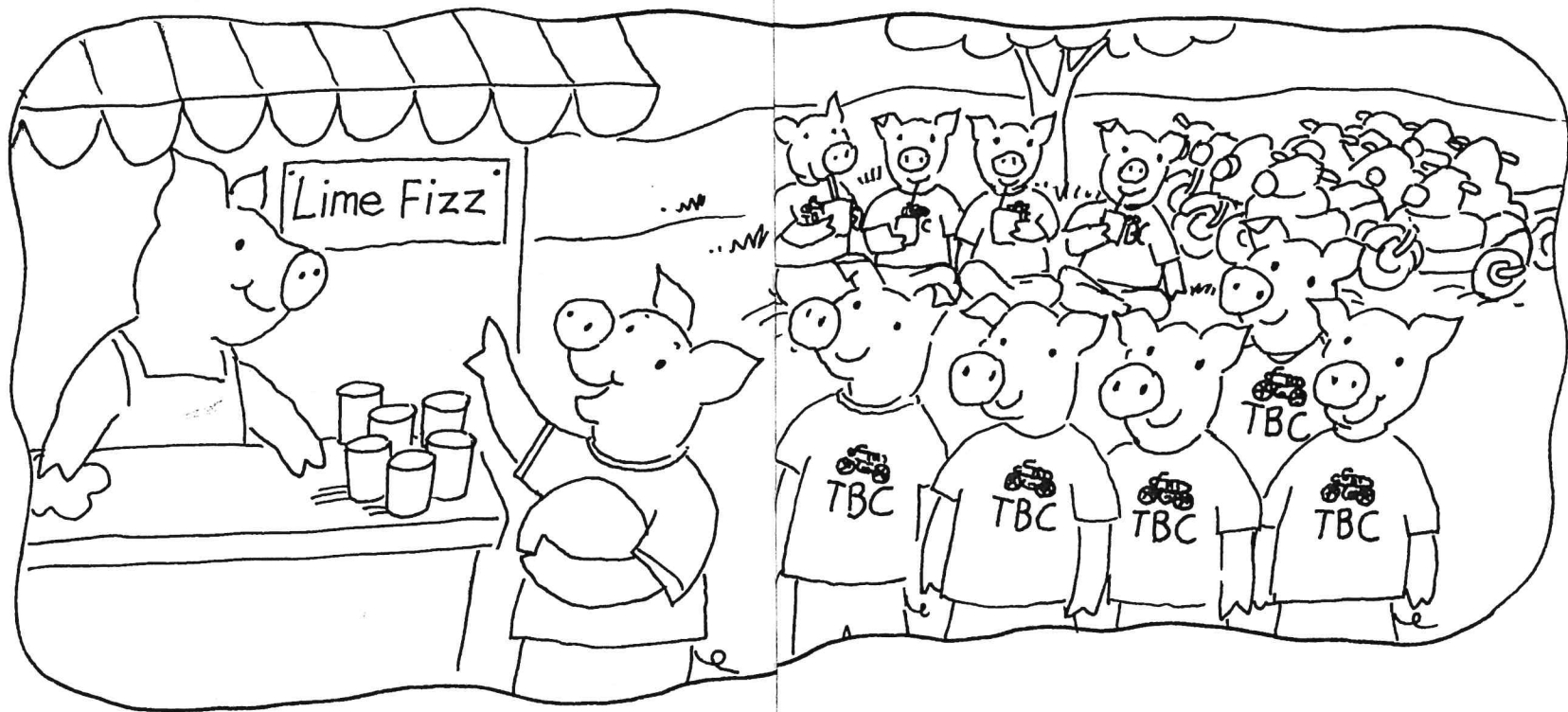
“Do you like to ride?”

“I won’t,” said Pete the Pig.



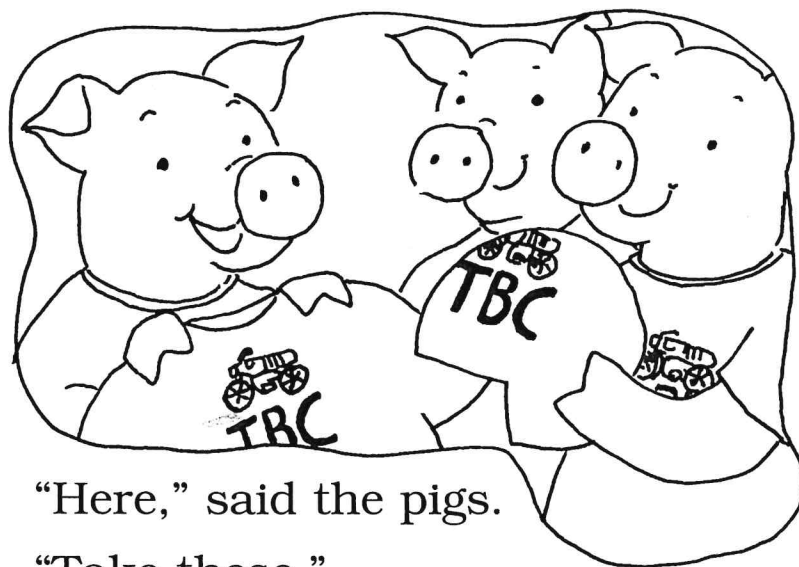
The bike path was long
