“I have many hats,” said Dog. “Pick any one,” he said to Bunny. “You will love these pretty hats!”

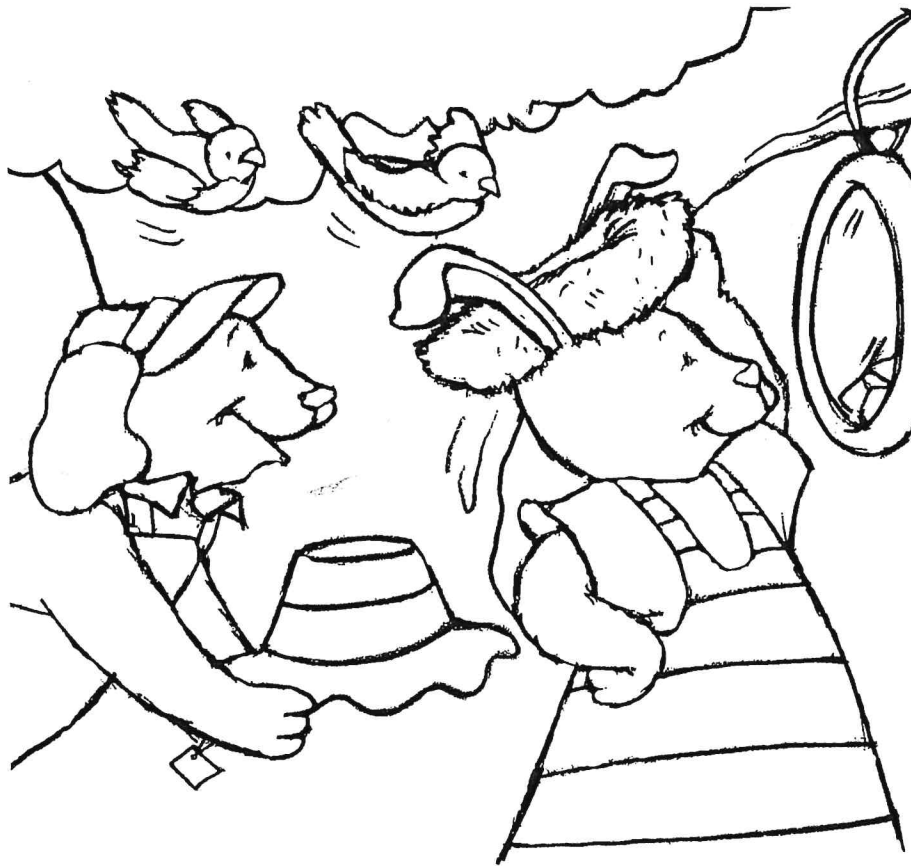


Bunny looked at the hats.

lumpy! Try this one,” said Dog.

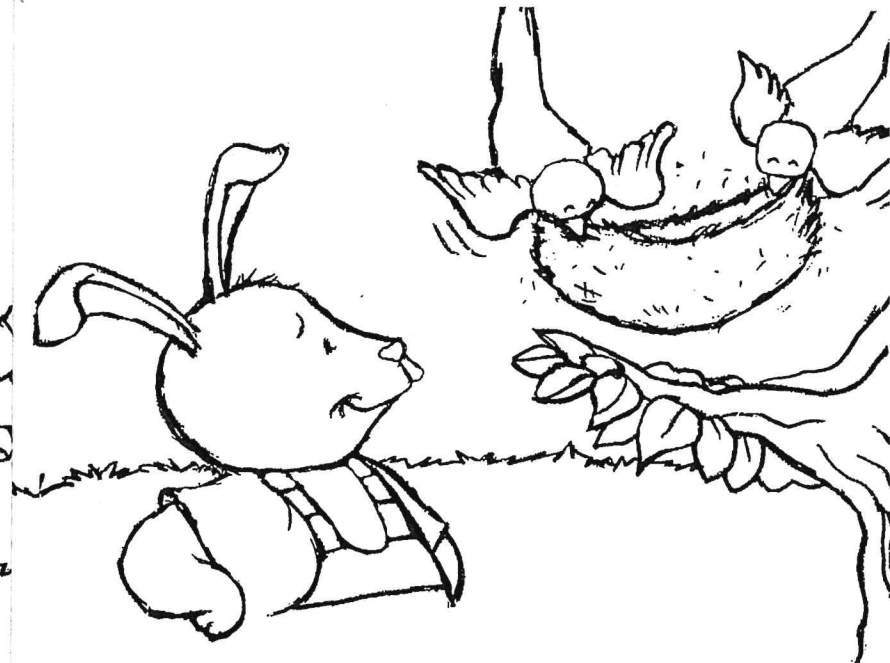


“No, no, no,” said Bunny.
